## LEGAL NOTICE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING # 2 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

The County of Noble intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally funded program administered by the State. The county is eligible for approximately \$150,000 of FY 2018 CDBG funding, providing the county meets applicable program requirements.

On April 18, 2018, the county conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other program requirements. Based on both citizen input and local officials' assessment of the county's needs, the county is proposing to undertake the following CDBG activities for Fiscal Year 2018.
