GMN Woodsfield Early Head Start and Head Start conducted a Sun, Fun and Safety Event on June 29 in the Village of Woodsfield City Park. Agencies and programs that participated in the event included Board of Developmental Disabilities/Early Intervention (740) 472- 1712; WIC (740) 472-1833; Monroe County Health Department (740) 472-1677; and Monroe County Library (740) 472-1954. Deputy Peska with Deputy Goofy, Deputy Ridley with Deputy Gale, and Deputy Miller with Deputy Max from the Monroe County Sheriff Department K-9 Unit were in attendance to visit with the children and their families. In addition to information and resources about summer safety, each agency gave out items such as bicycle helmets and interactive games.

Early Head Start provides services for pregnant women and families with children up to age 3 through home visits with parent educators. Socialization days occur at the Woodsfield Center in an Early Head Start classroom.

Head Start is a center-based program for children ages 3-5 years old. Classes run from August through May. Children will receive free kindergarten readiness activities and education. Free breakfast, lunch, an afternoon snack will also provided for Head Start.

In addition, the program provides vision, hearing, hemoglobin and lead screenings to enrolled applicants.
